House Rules

Resident and guest behaviour: Residents and their guests must not interfere with the reasonable peace, comfort and privacy of other residents.

Maintenance of rooms: Residents must maintain their rooms in a way that does not interfere with the reasonable comfort of other residents, and in a way that does not create a fire or health hazard. Residents must not intentionally or recklessly damage or destroy any part of their rooms or a facility in their rooms.

Common areas: Common areas are areas shared by different residents. Residents must make sure they and their guests leave common areas neat, clean and tidy after using them.

Guests: Residents must make sure their guests are aware of, and follow, the house rules.

Door locks and keys: Residents must not tamper with (or change) a door lock on the premises, or make copies of keys without the permission of the property manager.

Animals: Residents must not keep an animal on the premises without the permission of the property manager.

Smoking: Residents and guests must not smoke in common areas.

Quiet hours: No noise that can be heard outside your room from 10pm onwards.

Parking: Residents guests must not park on the premises.
